

The World Schools Purchases AED Device

The World Schools located at 138 Spit Brook Road in Nashua, NH educates and nurtures children from six weeks of age to Grade 7 (Grade 8 in 2011). With over 350 students attending the school, the administration and staff place a strong emphasis on child safety and being prepared for emergencies. Most staff members are certified in CPR and First Aid, with the Director, Lynn Ouellette also holding a First Responder Certification. The Automated External Defibrillator (AED) was purchased with funds raised from the 3rd Annual Silent Auction that was held from April 11th through the 16th. All staff members will receive training on how to operate the AED device on a child and an adult in cardiac arrest.
